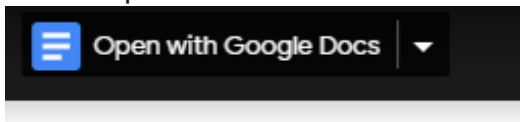
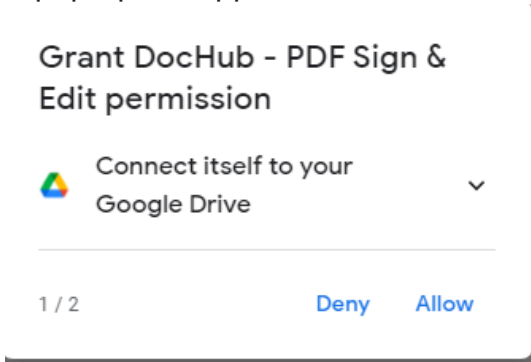


How to Install DocHub to Sign a PDF

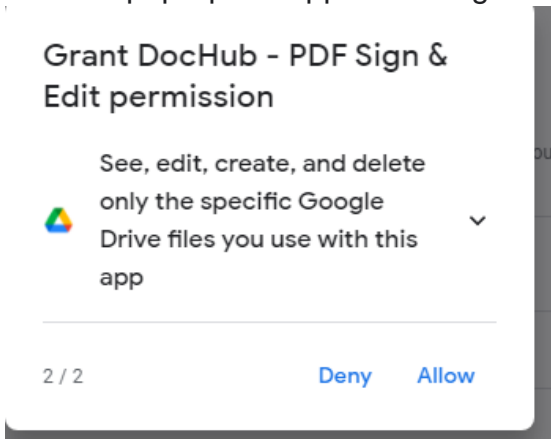
1. Open pdf in your google drive.
2. At the top of the screen it should say Open with Google Docs and have an arrow for a drop-down menu next to it.



3. Click drop-down arrow and select DocHub – PDF Sign & Edit.
4. A pop-up will appear, select allow.



5. Another pop-up will appear asking for edit permission, select allow.



6. A third pop-up will appear, select allow.
