## 1. MUSC 115 Live Ensemble Recording, 3 cr/33 lecture

### Discussion:

This will be a 2-week (10-day) course for K12 music educators, recording amateurs/professionals and live sound technicians. Course will be offered Summer 2008 using LCC digital/audio equipment providing training on the latest techniques. Training in this area is typically not part of music education in colleges forcing teachers to rely on untrained advice or sales professionals who may not understand the instructor's needs. This course will focus on types of microphones, pros and cons of stereo pair miking patterns and the role of acoustics on microphone selection and placement. This course will be on the Restricted list and graded on a Pass/Fail basis.
