Informational Items:

INFO 1 – PSYC& 220: Abnormal Psychology. The course was inadvertently not marked as meeting the Social Science requirement. The course plan has been corrected and the Distribution List has been updated for the next catalog (Summer 2024).

INFO 2 – Administrative Services Manager AAS: CMST courses were erroneously listed as recommended courses under the Natural Science requirement. These have been removed from the degree requirements, effective Summer 2024. Additional – Recommended Humanities course was actually a Social Science course. Revising to Distribution List. – TABLED

INFO 3 – NURS 247: Clinical Practicum. As discussed at the October 2023 meeting, NURS 247 will have the variable credit removed once the final cohort needing 10 credits has completed. The course currently has 8-10 credits and will be reduced to 8 credits effective Summer 2025.
