

Exceptional Faculty Grant Committee Spring 2012 Meeting May 11, 2012

The committee met to review applications for the 2012-2013 academic year and to review the Bylaws, Scoring Guidelines, and the Application Form to see if any updating or clarification was needed on those documents.

The Bylaws will be amended to reflect the application/award process will be extended to faculty twice yearly (fall and spring quarters). This change will increase opportunities and make better use of the funds.

The committee received a total of \$70,938.00 in requests while having \$50,000.00 to award. Deciding factors on the requests included but were not limited to verifying the requests addressed outcomes of the college, how the request would be woven into the individual teaching and effectiveness plans, clarity and worthiness of requests and how the requests met the guidelines. After reviewing and discussing each application, the following decisions were made:

- 4) Purchasing an iPad for one faculty member could set precedent for requests from others in kind. Purpose/benefit is unclear and there is a question as to why a stipend would be needed.
- 5) Art Association membership and conference would delivery little or no direct benefit to the college.
- 6) Stipend request for faculty to accompany student field trip is not necessary. Faculty member will be directed to speak with other adjunct Art faculty who take students on similar field trips to align with their current practice.
