  - **Values Speed Dating (Nicole) (20 min):**

      - How did you decide on your 3 values?
      - How do your values drive your work at LCC?
      - How have your values conflicted with your job here?
      - How have your values changed over time?
      - Bonus point: Add another value that you appreciate about the person across from you that wasn't on their list.
  - **Debrief on speed dating round (5-10 min):**
    - Was there an interaction you experienced that you didn't think you'd experience?
    - Was there someone who had a value that you'd never thought of?
    - Did a partner suggest any unexpected values they appreciate about you?
    - Have there been times when your values conflict with your job?
    - Here's how you keep these conversations going (Nicole)
      - If the values on your puzzle piece don't align with your values would it be helpful to connect with your boss to align your values?
