 - Financial Aid-
 - As of today, 230 students enrolled but not awarded; primary focus
 - SAP Appeals- no longer need to meet with academic advisor
 - Federal deadlines coming up
 - LCC Cares applications still coming in and getting awarded
 - October 1st- FAFSA opens for 2023
 - Work Force-
 - Questions on LCC Cares applications still coming in, applications still coming in
 - Nearly 1700 requests have come in
 - Anyone who has not been awarded or can't see award has likely only recently been awarded, or needs to be manually awarded

- Still awarding Emergency Aid as well
 - Future awards will be limited
 - Award amounts will be lower
 - Many students will not get aid every quarter
- Food pantry had over 50 students visit first week of Fall Quarter
 - Prepared lunch on Tuesdays, students can also get groceries
- o Testing- Navigate trainings will open soon
 - Advanced trainings will open soon as well
- o International- Study abroad options
- o BankMobile implementation- more information coming soon
